Current St. Joseph County ISD tax levy:

General Fund .2267 Special Education 2.4383

Special Education, extra voted .2925 (100% distributed to local school districts))

Career & Technical Education, voted .9932

<u>General Fund Budget:</u> As required in Section 624 of the Revised School Code, all local district boards of education in St. Joseph County have reviewed the proposed 2023-24 ISD General Fund Budget. All nine boards passed a resolution in support of the budget at their May meetings.
